Frequently Asked Questions

Who is Bill T. Hicks?

In 2010, Y-12 Federal Credit Union introduced the Bill T. Hicks Scholarship. This award is named for Bill T. Hicks, a former Y-12 FCU Board Chairman and educator in the Oak Ridge School System.

How much is being awarded?

A \$10,000 cash scholarship will be awarded to one student in addition to four students receiving \$5,000 cash scholarships.

How do I apply?

Who is eligible?

High school students graduating in 2024 with a minimum GPA of 2.5 are eligible.

When does the application close?

The initial application window will close at **11:59 p.m. EST on Jan. 15, 2024.**

Do I have to be a member of Y-12 FCU to apply?

You must be a member of Y-12 FCU to be considered.

What is the application process?

Where do I upload the required documents?

When and how will applicants be notified?

Applicants will be notified by **March 1, 2024.**

What happens after acceptance?

Winners of Y-12 FCU scholarships must return the letter of acceptance and proof of enrollment for the chosen institution by **Sept. 30, 2024.**

Failure to notify Y-12 FCU of acceptance will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
