



# BILL T. HICKS Scholarship

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Who is Bill T. Hicks?

In 2010, Y-12 Federal Credit Union introduced the Bill T. Hicks Scholarship. This award is named for Bill T. Hicks, a former Y-12 FCU Board Chairman and educator in the Oak Ridge School System.

### How much is being awarded?

A one-time award of \$5,000.00 is to be used for education-related expenses. Four scholarships will be awarded.

### How do I apply?

### Who is eligible?

High school students graduating in 2023

### When does the application close?

The initial application window will close at **midnight (12 a.m.) Jan. 15th, 2023.**

### Do I have to be a member at Y-12 FCU to apply?

You must be a member of Y-12 FCU to be considered.

### Where do I upload required documents?

### When and how will applicants be notified?

Applicants will be notified no later than **May 30, 2023.**

### What happens after acceptance?

Winners of Y-12 FCU scholarships must return the letter of acceptance and proof of enrollment for chosen institution no later than **Sept. 30, 2023.**

Failure to notify Y-12 FCU of acceptance will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
